(contd ... page 1) Explaining about the three options under which the houses would be constructed, he said under the first option, Government would transfer Rs. 1, 80,000 directly into the bank accounts of beneficiaries who want to construct the dwelling units on their own. Under the second option, Government would transfer the labour expenses directly into the bank accounts of beneficiaries after supplying cement, steel and door frames and under the third option, Government will fully take upon the responsibility of construction. In all options, sand would be provided free to the beneficiaries while quality steel, cement and door frames would be supplied at subsidized rates as per the policy adopted in all Jagananna colonies across the State, he clarified. Government would also arrange bank loans up to Rs. 35,000 each for all beneficiaries at 25 paise interest for expediting the construction, he said, adding the beneficiaries are free to choose the option. So far, house sites were given to 30, 75,000 poor women across the State, out of which 21 lakh women were sanctioned houses each worth Rs. 2. 5 lakh, he said, adding that the worth would go up to Rs. 5 or Rs. 10 lakh. This amounts to creating propery worth Rs. 3 lakh crore on the whole, he said. Speaking about the TIDCO houses, he said the Govrernment has been handing over the 300 square feet TIDCO houses just for Re 1 to 1, 43,000 beneficiries with full rights while the TDP Government tried to exploit the beneficires by forcing them to pay Rs. 7.20 lakh per each TIDCO flat in instalmens over several years. It amounts to cheating the beneficires, he remarked. Guntur District Collector M. Venugopala Reddy, Municipal Administration Minister A. UP to have 22 operational airports in 3 yrs: Scindia

Kanpur, May 26 (UNI) Union Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia on Friday said that Uttar Pradesh will have 22 new airports in the next three years while making a significant announcement that steps will be taken to begin air service from Kanpur to Delhi very soon. After the inauguration of the new terminal building of Kanpur Airport, the Union Minister said, "We have announced 59 new routes and 122 new routes will be announced in the future. We have the vision to connect Kanpur with Pantnagar, Aligarh, Moradabad and Shravasti. There are currently 11 airports operating in the state and 11 more airports will be started over the next three years. UP will get 22 new airports." He said, "Be it Chitrakoot, Moradabad, Jhansi, Ghazipur, Aligarh,

will soon be able to handle 10 lakh passenor Shravasti, airport facilities will be provided at all these places." Scindia said that today a new sparkle is visible in the eyes of the people of Kanpur and there are two reasons behind it. "The first reason is the recently concluded civic body elections in which UP's double-engine government has now transformed into a triple-engine government. The second reason is that the Kanpur airport's longawaited expansion and modernisation are now complete, a brand-new terminal is being officially opened to the public today," he said. He said, "There are currently five international airports operational in UP and in the near future, Jewar and Ayodhya will also be complete.
