



Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister to Dedicate Jaklair – Krishna New Railway Line to the Nation

Hyderabad, Sept 30 (TIM Bureau) : Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister will dedicate New Railway line between Jaklair – Krishna to the Nation and flag-off the inaugural train service from Krishna railway station to Kacheguda (through video conference) on 01st October, 2023 from function to be held at Mahabubnagar. The Hon'ble Prime Minister

will also dedicate to the Nation and lay foundation stone for several other developmental projects in important sectors like road, petroleum and natural gas and higher education worth more than Rs 13,500 crore during the function. Telangana has been witness to rapid transformation of its rail network in the recent past. Be it creation of New Lines, expansion of existing lines, electrification of

rail lines or introduction of new passenger amenities, the State has seen never-before growth. Taking this transformative growth forward, a new line between Jaklair – Krishna is being dedicated to the Nation by the Hon'ble Prime Minister which will usher in a new dawn of rail development in Southern Telangana. The introduction of train services in this route connecting the southern districts in Telangana with both State Capital and Raichur in Karnataka will aid in the socio-economic development of the people in the region. The new rail line between Jaklair – Krishna for a distance of

37.48 Kms is part of Mahabubnagar – Munirabad New Line Project which is being executed by South Central Railway. Commissioning of this section signifies completion of the entire Telangana portion of the Project i.e., Devarakadra – Krishna (65.825 kms). The Jaklair – Krishna new line project has been completed at a cost of nearly Rs 504.89 Cr. Four new station buildings viz., Jaklair, Maganoor, Makhth and Kumsi halt are constructed apart from one existing station at Krishna.



Andhra CID serves notice to Lokesh in Amaravati Inner Ring Road case

Amaravati, Sep 30 (IANS) : Andhra Pradesh's CID on Saturday served notice to Telugu Desam Party (TDP) General Secretary Nara Lokesh in the Amaravati Inner Ring Road case, asking him to appear before it for questioning on October 4. CID officials served notice under Section 41A of the Criminal Procedure Code. As the TDP leader has been staying in New Delhi for the last few days, a CID team went to the national capital to serve the notice. Lokesh has been directed to make himself available for questioning at CID office here at 10 a.m. on October 4. The CID had filed a memo in Vijayawada ACB Court on September 26, naming Lokesh as the 14th accused in the case.

The TDP General Secretary had moved Andhra Pradesh High Court for anticipatory bail in the case. During the hearing, the CID informed the court that it will issue notice to Lokesh under Section 41A of Criminal Procedure Code. Since the arrest is not apprehended in the case, the court disposed of TDP leader's petition after directing him to cooperate in the investigation. Lokesh is son of TDP supremo and former Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, who is already in judicial custody in Skill Development scam. The CID has already named Naidu as an accused in the Amaravati Inner Ring Road case and AP FiberNet case and filed Prisoner Transit (PT) warrant petitions against him in Vijayawada ACB Court.

Ex-minister Krishna Yadav joins BJP

Hyderabad, Sept 30 (IANS) : Former minister Krishna Yadav, Chittaranjan Das, ZPTC, Rekha Satyanarayana, Bandala Ramachandra Reddy and many sarpanches and MPTCs today joined BJP in the presence of Union Minister Kishan Reddy at the State BJP office at Nampally. Kishan Reddy invited them into the party by covering them with the party scarves. Speaking on the occasion, Kishan Reddy targeted Chief Minister K Chandrasekhar Rao and wondered whether the people of the State needed him, who does not participate

in development activities. He said the people were watching everything in the State. Reddy said KCR and his family would be confined to their farmhouse after 90 days. "In the last nine years, Prime Minister Modi paved the way for the development of Telangana with Rs 9 lakh crore. At the ground level, people are supporting the BJP", he added. About the PM's visit to the State, he said Narendra Modi was visiting the State to inaugurate several development programmes. He said no matter how many conspiracies the BRS party hatches, the BJP would form the government in Telangana. He said there was a positive at-

mosphere for the BJP in the State and several surveys had predicted that BRS ministers and MLAs were likely to lose. Modi is coming to Telangana to inaugurate, lay foundation stones and perform bhoomi pujas for several development projects. Prime Minister Narendra Modi himself inaugurated various projects, including development of Secunderabad railway station, Vande Bharat trains, Kazipet railway wagon factory and others. In the last nine years, the Central government has spent Rs 9 lakh crore on the development of Telangana," he added.
