

Skyroot dedicates success of first private rocket mission to space reforms brought by PM

(contd .. page 1) It has given five authorizations to the Space NGEs for undertaking space activities in India, in six months and signed Sixteen MoUs. Till date, IN-SPACE has received more than 150 applications from Space NGEs for Authorization, Facilitation, and Promotion. In their continued efforts to give India's space sector a new and dynamic dimension, IN-SPACE's enabling of Skyroot's launch vehicle initiates a new chapter in India's space domain. IN-SPACE Chairman Pawan K Goenka said "India holds tremendous potential in space and has been an enabler of epoch-making space missions for decades." This maiden rocket launch for Skyroot Aerospace is perhaps the most important milestone for the Indian private space sector since the space reforms announced by the Union Government and hints at the rapid transformative journey we're witnessing in India's space sector, he said. "Though one small step, it is a giant leap to demonstrate the capabilities of the Indian Space sector", he added. "Heartiest congratulations to all involved in the success of 'Prarambh' mission. A new space journey has begun", he said. The lift off of VIKRAM-S from Sriharikota happened at 11.30 IST today. The ranging and tracking operations for VIKRAM-S were handled by SDSC SHAR facility at ISRO. Telemetry data was captured by ISTRAC station of ISRO and relayed to the control room. The launch of the Skyroot VKS rocket has been possible with the seamless joint efforts of various ISRO centres including SDSC SHAR, ISTRAC and VSSC, Skyroot team and IN-SPACE. The Technical Mission Readiness review committee members from ISRO and IN-SPACE rigorously reviewed launch vehicle and integration preparation and gave the final launch clearance.

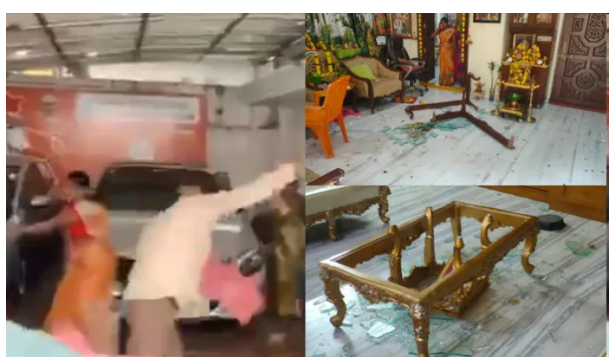

Record Kavitha's statement, Revanth Reddy demands police



Hyderabad, Nov 18: The State Congress unit has demanded that Hyderabad Police record the statement of TRS MLC K Kavitha, who admitted that a few persons had approached her

to join the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). The TRS MLC's statement should be taken up as Suo Moto and thorough investigation should be conducted. All those, who were involved in the episode, should be arrested, demanded TPCC president A Revanth Reddy on Friday. Addressing media persons here, the TPCC president charged that both BJP and ruling TRS were indulging in blame-game. All these tactics were being adopted by the parties only to cover up their failures at the Central and State level, he said. In the guise of controversies, both TRS and BJP were trying to escape the people's wrath. While BJP was misusing ED and other Central probe agencies,

the ruling TRS was forcing the State organisations to act, Revanth Reddy said. The Congress party also charged that there was no clarity on paddy procurement and demanded the State government to make things clear to the farmers. Similarly, there was no discussion on filling up vacancies in government departments. "The BJP and TRS are enacting dramas of attack and counter attack to deviate the people attention from different key issues," Revanth Reddy said.

Uttam hails HC order on Dalit Bandhu scheme



Hyderabad, Nov.18 : The Congress party on Friday welcomed the verdict of the Telangana High Court calling for impartiality in the selection of Dalit Bandhu scheme beneficiaries. In a media statement here today, Congress MP & former TPCC president N. Uttam Kumar Reddy and TPCC SC Cell Chairman Preetam, said the High Court's verdict has vindicated the allegation levelled by the Congress party of partiality and politicisation of the Dalit Bandhu scheme. "I've pointed out on multiple occasions that the local TRS MLAs were misusing the Dalit Bandhu schemes for cheap political gains. They were selecting beneficiaries by taking huge commissions up to Rs 2 lakh to Rs. 5 lakh. Now the High Court has made it clear that the recommendation of MLAs is not required and only the committee set by the State Government must evaluate applications," they said adding that the

committees must comprise of only officials and not the TRS party functionaries as is the case now. It may be mentioned that Jannu Nutan Babu and three others approached the High Court with a complaint that the Warangal District Collector was not considering their application for the Dalit Bandhu scheme as they were not members of the TRS party. The petitioners said they were educated and jobless and deserve to get financial aid under the scheme. But the Warangal District Collector was not forwarding their application to the committee concerned as their names were not recommended by the local TRS MLA. After hearing the petition, Justice P. Madhavi Devi directed

that the applications filed by petitioners be referred to an appropriate committee for verification and consideration in accordance with the rules and order of preference. "The High Court has delivered a landmark judgment and this will benefit thousands of poor SC families across the Telangana State, who were being deprived of Dalit Bandhu beneficiaries by the corrupt TRS MLAs. This is a slap on the face of Chief Minister K. Chandrashekhara Rao, who is trying to manipulate the entire system by linking welfare schemes with the ruling TRS party. In view of the High Court's verdict, the State Government must ensure that the committee which evaluates the applications is allowed to function independently and transparently," he demanded. Uttam Kumar Reddy also pointed out that the stand taken by the Warangal District Collector of refusing to entertain Dalit Bandhu applications in the absence of a recommendation by TRS MLA has exposed how the ruling party was trying to control the Executive. He also said many IAS and IPS officers have been working as TRS functionaries. They are simply following the dictates of TRS bosses on all matters and not giving any prominence to the rules and regulations. The Congress MP reiterated the demand that Gram Sabha should be empowered to select the Dalit Bandhu beneficiaries. Stating that the Congress party was all set to return to power in 2023, he warned that the next Congress Govt would take action against such sycophant officials on a priority basis.

He claimed that Kavitha was cornered as her political career had reached the last stage and added that he could understand the pain of the TRS party MLC. Aravind welcomed the statement of Kavitha that she would contest against him in the next Lok Sabha elections and added that Kavitha had agreed to her request to take on him while hoping that the TRS party MLC will stand by her word. Aravind said he was now

eagerly waiting for the issuance of the 2024 Lok Sabha election notification. Referring to his claims that Kavitha called up Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge, he said a senior office-bearer of the Congress told him about the development involving Kavitha. Alleging that Chief Minister K Chandrashekhara Rao was tapping the phones of all Opposition party leaders, he asked the CM to find out the truth behind allegations by taking out the phone call list of his daughter while reminding that the CM himself alleged that his daughter received phone calls from the BJP leaders. He made it clear that both Congress and the TRS party leaders were in touch with him in Telangana.

Siddipet: Harish Rao announces gold medal for girl students who top Inter exams



(By Our Skyline Staff Reporter) Siddipet, Nov 18: Finance Minister T Harish Rao has said that he will present a gold medal to government college-going students in the Siddipet district. Addressing the students after laying foundation for new buildings of Government Girls School and Government Junior College for Girls in Siddipet on Friday, the minister said he will present the medal if any girl student in any group-MPC-BIPC-CEC-HEC-groups scores the top ten marks in the coming board examinations. The government will spend Rs 4 crore on girls' colleges, school and other infrastructure development here. Rao said that they will build the government junior college building with an outlay of Rs 1.5 crore while the girl's school will be constructed with a budget of

Rs 1 crore. Apart from this, the minister said that the government will spend another Rs one crore the government will develop a playground that will have a running track, basketball court, volleyball court, open gym, and many others, spending an additional Rs 1.5 crore. Elaborating on the government's efforts in providing free and quality education in the government sector, Rao said that the government is spending Rs 7,300 crore on infrastructure development in schools under the Mana Vuru Mana Badi programme. He further said the government will soon give hygiene kits to girls who were studying VIIIth class and above in government institutes by spending Rs 70 crore.
