

## Andhra HC directs CID not to arrest Lokesh till Oct 4

The High Court passed the interim order on petitions of Lokesh, son of TDP supremo and former Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, who is already in judicial custody in Skill Development scam, seeking anticipatory bail in both the cases. The court took up, post lunch, the petitions for hearing and later adjourned the same till October 4.

It also adjourned hearing on Lokesh's anticipatory bail petition in AP FiberNet case. Earlier, the court disposed of a petition filed by Lokesh for anticipatory bail in Amaravati Inner Ring Road case after the CID informed that it will issue notice to Lokesh under Section 41A of Criminal Procedure Code.

Advocate General Subrahmanyam Sriram informed the court that Lokesh will be issued a notice under 41A of CrPC for questioning in

the case. Since the arrest is not apprehended in the case, the court disposed of TDP leader's petition after directing him to cooperate in the investigation. The CID had Tuesday filed a memo in Vijayawada ACB Court, naming Lokesh as the 14th accused in the case.

The CID has already named Naidu as an accused in the Amaravati Inner Ring Road case and AP FiberNet case and filed Prisoner Transit (PT) warrant petitions against him in Vijayawada ACB Court. Naidu has also filed petitions in the High Court for anticipatory bail in both the cases. In May 2022, the CID had registered an FIR against Chandrababu Naidu, former Municipal Administration Minister Dr P. Narayana, Heritage Foods Ltd, and others, for alleged irregularities in the construction of an internal ring road in Amaravati.



## CS directs officials to get ready with details for CEC meeting

Hyderabad, Sept 29 (NSS) : Chief Secretary Santhi Kumari asked the officials to come prepared with all details for the upcoming visit of the Election Commission of India (ECI) officials to the State. The Chief Election Commis-

sioner along with other EC members will be in Hyderabad from October 3. The EC members will hold meetings with enforcement agencies, district collectors, SPs/CPs and also with the senior officials of the State government during their three day visit.

Santhi Kumari held a meeting with senior officers here on Friday and took stock of the arrangements made for the visit of the ECI officials to the Telangana.

On the occasion, the Chief Secretary directed the officials to demonstrate the readiness of the State government towards conducting the elections.

"As the elections are to be held in a couple of months thorough knowledge of the poll related issues should be there and officials should provide all the details in a uniform manner. Details of assured minimum facilities at the polling stations should be provided. The disabled welfare department officials were told to procure wheel chairs and kept at the polling stations in consultation with the district collectors.

Vacancies of AEROs/EROs should be immediately filled. Details on integrated border check posts should also be made available to the EC officials," she said.



## Vizag turns hub for ganja sale & betting : Dr K. Narayana

Visakhapatnam, Sept 29 (NSS) : CPI National Secretary Dr K. Narayana today said Visakhapatnam had become the capital of ganja sale and Betting games. He alleged that Rs 350 crore were found with an anonymous person, who was involved in the betting racket and wondered as to how many hundreds of crore rupees were involved in the scam with others, who are involved in the scam and the sale of ganja. ## Cauvery dispute : K'taka bandh successful, state returning to normalcy

Bengaluru, Sep 29 (IANS) : The Karnataka bandh called to oppose the release of water to Tamil Nadu on Friday has been successful with people in most parts of the state extending their support to the bandh call. With no untoward incidents of violence being reported, the state is returning to normalcy. The buses, cabs and autos have started to ply on the roads. Shops, commercial complexes and malls remained open to the public in Bengaluru. The other major cities of south-eastern Karnataka, where bandh was

observed in toto are also returning to normalcy. R. Hitendra, ADGP, Law and Order, said that the bandh was peaceful all across the state. No reports of violence till now been reported. IGPs, SPs, and City Police Commissioners are on patrol. The security is beefed up in border areas, and highways, he added. Bengaluru Police Commissioner B. Dayana nd stated that the police had taken more than 1,000 protestors into detention. The security across the city is intact and officers are still on patrol. The prohibitory orders



will be in place till 12 midnight on Friday, he added. The buses attached to Karnataka Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) and Bengaluru Metropolitan Transport

Corporation (BMTCL) have also started their operations. Kannada film industry had also staged a protest supporting the Karnataka state on the Cauvery issue.

## TDP calls for five-minute 'noisy protest' against Chandrababu's arrest

Amaravati, Sep 29 (IANS) : Andhra Pradesh's opposition Telugu Desam Party (TDP) has called for a noisy protest for five minutes on Saturday against 'illegal' arrest of its leader and former chief minister N. Chandrababu Naidu in Skill Development Corporation scam. The party on Friday appealed to people to make some noise from 7 p.m. to 7.05 p.m. on September 30 as a mark of protest. It called on 5 crore people of the state to show their solidarity with Chandrababu Naidu by participating in the protest. The TDP urged the people to ring the bell or beat utensil, blow whistle or honk horns of their vehicles so that the voice is heard by 'psycho Jagan in Tadepalli palace'. Naidu's daughter-in-law Nara Brahmani requested people to make some noise for five minutes to convey their protest to the government. Brahmani posted on 'X' that if the

wrongdoings of rulers are not stopped, it is dangerous for democracy. "If people remain silent, this will unleash injustice. Hence, this is my appeal to the people of Andhra Pradesh. You know Chandrababu Naidu very well.

Speak out that his illegal detention is wrong. To show your support to Chandrababu Naidu, come out on the streets for 5 minutes and ring the bells or beat utensils or blow whistle.

If you are travelling on roads, honk the horn," she said. TDP general secretary Nara Lokesh appealed to people to show how they react to an illegal arrest. "Let



us show that if false cases are booked, we will not back down. This is the moment to prove that all the Telugu people are in support of Chandrababu Naidu who symbolises honesty and Telugu glory. In support of the impec-

cable politician Chandrababu Naidu, let's raise the voice of the people democratically," he said. Chandrababu Naidu was arrested by the CID on September 9 in multi-crore Skill Development scam.

## People will not believe the promises made by CM KCR : Vikramarka

Hyderabad, Sept 29 (IANS) : CLP leader Bhatti Vikramarka today said that people would not believe the words of CM KCR's family and added that False promises were being made to gain electoral mileage. He alleged that the CM's family members took loans and robbed the contractors. "Due to exploitation and commissions, the government is in debt. We have a budget to fulfil the promises made by the Congress party.

There will be no exploitation and commissions in the budget, so there will be no dearth of funds to fulfil our promises," he said. Bhatti Vikramarka said that the BRS party was spreading misinformation on congress party's promises.

## MIM exploiting Old City voters, alleges Hyderabad DCC president

Hyderabad, Sept 29 (IANS) : Hyderabad DCC president Sameer Waliullah has accused the MIM of exploiting the poor people of the Old City of Hyderabad for decades by inciting religious feelings and diverting attention from their failures. He alleged that the MIM leaders have created an atmosphere wherein people are asked to vote for them without asking any questions about their performance. Consequently, the majority in the Old City continue to struggle with poverty. He alleged that the Owaisi brothers accumulated wealth. Waliullah said MIM president Asaduddin Owaisi is recycling old strategies

to confront the Congress party, which envisions a positive change in the upcoming Assembly elections. He described Asaduddin Owaisi as a covert ally of the BJP. He alleged that Owaisi challenged Rahul Gandhi to contest Lok Sabha election from Hyderabad to appease Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Waliullah highlighted that the world recognizes Rahul Gandhi's battles against the BJP and that BJP affiliates are constantly trying to defame him. He challenged Owaisi's appeal for Muslim votes for the BRS, questioning the rationale of supporting a party that has failed to deliver on its promises to the Muslim community. He also challenged

Owaisi to explain why the Old City of Hyderabad remains backward, despite his decades-long rule. He pointed out that the MIM has been contesting Assembly elections from the Old City since 1969 and held the Hyderabad Lok Sabha seat since 1984. He argued that the people of the Old City have always voted for the MIM in the municipal elections, but have only been met with disappointment. Sameer Waliullah also noted that the MIM supported the Telugu Desam Party when it came to power, joined the UPA when the Congress came to power in 2004 and sat on the lap of the TRS when it came to power in 2014.
