

Maha CM's son enters Ujjain Mahakal temple's sanctum sanctorum despite ban; triggers row

Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde's MP son Shrikant Shinde has courted controversy after he was allowed entry into the sanctum sanctorum of the Mahakaleshwar temple here despite a ban, prompting the authorities to order a probe.

The incident occurred on Thursday evening, sources from the temple said. The opposition Congress took a strong objection, saying while common citizens have to wait in queues for hours to take 'darshan' of the deity, VIPs were allowed entry into the sanctum sanctorum despite a ban. Shinde, who represents the Kalyan Lok Sabha constituency in Maharashtra's Thane



district, entered the 'garbha griha' (sanctum sanctorum) along with his wife and two others to worship the deity on Thursday evening, the temple sources said.

However, a controversy erupted over it as soon as a video of the incident went viral since entry of devotees into the sanctum sanctorum has been banned for nearly a year, they said. The Mahakaleshwar temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva. It is one of the 12 'jyotirlinga' temples in

the country and attracts a large number of devotees throughout the year. Expressing displeasure over the episode, Congress MLA Mahesh Parmar on Friday said, "While a common devotee has to stand in long queues and wait for hours for the darshan of Lord Mahakaleshwar, the VIPs were allowed to enter the garbha griha despite a ban on entering it." "This is against rules and we strongly oppose it," he told reporters. Chairman of the temple committee and Ujjain district collector Neeraj Kumar Singh said, "Nobody is allowed to enter the garbha griha. This (Shinde's) is an unauthorised entry and I have directed the temple administrator to take immediate action in this matter."

Husband, his brother held over woman's murder in Maharashtra's Palghar district

A 21-year-old woman's husband and his brother have been arrested over her murder in Maharashtra's Palghar district which they



tried to pass off as death due to health reasons, an official said on Saturday.

Vasai resident Ismail Choudhary (27) got into a fight with his wife

Khurshida Khatun on Wednesday accusing her of not being faithful to him and later strangled her, the official said citing the FIR.

He then took the body to his brother's house and made a fake death certificate showing that Khurshida had died due to some ailment. He also told Khurshida's brother in Pune that she succumbed to some health complications.

On a complaint by the woman's kin, the Naigaon police probed the matter and arrested Choudhary and his brother on Thursday for murder and destruction of evidence, the official added.

Salman Khan gets fresh death threat: 'Pay Rs 5 crore to end enmity with Lawrence Bishnoi'

Bollywood star Salman Khan has received a fresh extortion-cum-death threat from the dreaded Lawrence Bishnoi gang around a week after politician-businessman Baba Siddique was shot dead in Mumbai.

The gang has demanded Rs five crore from the actor. The extortion threat was received by the Mumbai Traffic Police.

The message on WhatsApp said: "If Salman Khan wants to stay alive and wants to end the enmity with Lawrence Bishnoi, then he must pay up Rs 5 crore. Do not take this lightly, otherwise, Salman Khan's condition will be worse than Baba Siddique." Taking the message

seriously, the Mumbai Police have started a probe into the antecedents of the sender, his/her intentions behind the extortion-death threats.

It may be mentioned that Salman Khan and his father Salim Khan are on the radar of the Lawrence Bishnoi gang. Meanwhile, investigations have revealed that the gang was preparing to buy state-of-the-art weapons AK 47, AK 92 and M 16 from Pakistan and the Turkish-made Zigana pistol.

Around 60 to 70 people were keeping track of Salman Khan's routine and movements, especially at his Bandra house, Panvel

farmhouse and Goregaon Film City. In a related development, Mumbai Police Commissioner Vivek Phansalkar met Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, who also holds the Home portfolio. Siddique's son and Vandre East MLA Zeeshan Siddique too met the top police officials.

Earlier, Fadnavis has said that five to six angles have emerged behind the killing of Baba Siddique.



Two MBBS students suspended from hostel for ragging fresher in Mumbai

The incident took place this week at a hostel on the medical college campus in

The accused students, who were allegedly drunk, had asked a fresher to dance, he said.

The incident was brought to the notice of the medical college's anti-ragging committee on Thursday, which then decided to suspend the two students from their hostel for a year, he added.

BJP implements its manifesto, Congress deceives voters: Mungantiwar

Maharashtra minister and BJP leader Sudhir Mungantiwar on Thursday said his party implements its manifesto while the Congress deceives voters.

Speaking to reporters, he said the BJP has invited suggestions from citizens for its manifesto for the November 20 Maharashtra assembly polls.

"The Congress deceives voters by not implementing its manifesto. The BJP makes sure its manifesto gets implemented. We are determined to undertake measures for the betterment

of the people," he claimed.

Attacking opposition parties, he said the corpus required for implementation of the 6th and 7th pay commissions was much higher than money needed

Bribe-seeking revenue official on the run as ACB nabs middleman

A revenue official from Maharashtra's Thane district, who had demanded a bribe from a company, is absconding after the Anti-Corruption Bureau apprehended a



private person acting as his conduit, an official said on Friday.

The firm's owners recently purchased 5 acres of land at Shenve village in Shahapur

taluka and applied to talati (revenue official) Dyaneshwar Devidas Shisode to get its details updated in government records, said ACB Deputy Commissioner of Police Harsh Chavan.

However, Shisode demanded Rs 8 lakh through middleman Ashok Dattatraya Varkute (62) to get the work done, he said.

After receiving a complaint, the ACB laid a trap and nabbed Varkute on Thursday when he accepted a bag containing Rs 2 lakh cash and bundles of dummy notes.

However, the revenue official got wind of the ACB action and went underground, the official said.

A case has been registered under the Prevention of Corruption Act, he said, adding that efforts are being made to trace the absconding talati.

Enforcement Directorate raids Muda's office in Mysuru, team of 12 officials on spot

New Delhi. A team of 12 Enforcement Directorate officials raided the office of the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) on Friday in connection with the land allotment case, in which Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah is also named. The officials conducted a meeting with senior MUDA officials, including Commissioner AN Raghunandan. The officials are likely to seize documents pertaining to the case following the meeting. The probe agency will question all MUDA officials to ascertain their involvement in the land allotment case. The

development comes a couple of days after K Marigowda, believed to be a close aide of Siddaramaiah, resigned as MUDA chairperson citing health reasons.

Speaking to the media after resigning, Marigowda dismissed claims that he resigned due to political pressure. However, he claimed that he resigned at Chief Minister Siddaramaiah's direction. "I have met the minister and submitted my resignation. The Chief Minister instructed me to resign, and following his directions, I did so," he said. "There was no pressure on me to resign. My



health is genuinely not in good condition, so I am stepping down voluntarily. I have known the Chief Minister for more than 40 years. He appointed me as district president and never asked me to do anything illegal, including anything related to MUDA. I am resigning for personal reasons; I have suffered two strokes and cannot continue," he added. The

Opposition has demanded Siddaramaiah's resignation after the Karnataka High Court dismissed his petition, challenging the legality of the Governor's decision to prosecute him over alleged irregularities in the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) scheme. The case against the Chief Minister pertains to allegations that compensatory sites were allotted to his wife, BM Parvathi, in an upmarket area in Mysuru that had higher property value as compared to the location of her land that had been acquired by MUDA.

BMC removes 7,389 banners and boards within 48 hours

With the implementation of the code of conduct for the Maharashtra assembly elections, the work of removing political hoardings, banners and posters has intensified across Mumbai. The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) has removed 7,389 illegal banners, posters, flags and hoardings in the past 48 hours. In a release issued on Thursday, October 17, the civic body said its licensing department initiated a special drive from October 15 in this regard after the Election Commission of India announced the poll schedule for the state. A total of 942 posters, 817 boards, 596 hoardings, 3,703 banners and 1,331 flags across Mumbai have been removed during this drive, the release informed. BMC commissioner-cum-administrator Bhushan Gagrani, who is also district election officer for Mumbai city and suburban districts, has directed officials to strictly enforce the model code of conduct and has urged political parties to obtain permissions for displaying banners and hoardings only in designated areas, it added.
