

Aadhaar-based face authentication transactions cross all-time high of 10.6 million in May

Ahmedabad: Aadhaar-based face authentication transactions for service delivery are gaining strong momentum since its launch in October 2021, with monthly transactions touching an all-time high of 10.6 million in May. This is the second month in a row to register more than 10 million face authentication transactions. The number of face authentication transactions is increasing and the monthly number increased by 39 percent in May as compared to such transactions recorded in January 2023, indicating its increasing usage. The AI/ML based face authentication solution developed in-house by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) is now used by 47 organizations including state government departments, central government ministries and some banks. In many uses, it is used to register beneficiaries under the Aayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana; for authentication of beneficiaries in PM Kisan Yojana and generation of Digital Life Certificates by pensioners at the ICICI. It is used to mark the presence of employees in some government departments and to open bank accounts by their business correspondents in some leading banks. In several states, the government of Andhra Pradesh is using Aadhaar-based face authentication under the e-KYC Nesham scheme for the Jaganna Vidya Devena scheme for fee reimbursement to eligible higher education students and for welfare disbursements to economically backward women. Face authentication offers features such as ease of use, fast authentication and is preferred as an additional method to strengthen authentication success rates along with fingerprint and OTP authentication. It receives live images for authentication. It is safe against any video replay attacks and still photo authentication attempts by anti-social elements. Face authentication is also working as a strong alternative and helps senior citizens and all those who have problems with the quality of their fingerprints due to various reasons including manual work or health issues. In May also, UIDAI implemented 14.86 million Aadhaar updates following residents' requests. Aadhaar-KYC service continues to play a pivotal role in the banking and non-banking financial services sectors by providing a transparent and improved customer experience and helping ease of doing business. More than 254 million e-KYC transactions were done in May alone. By the end of May 2023, the cumulative number of Aadhaar e-KYC transactions has crossed 15.2 billion. Consistent adoption of e-KYC significantly reduces customer acquisition costs for companies such as financial institutions, telecom service providers, etc. Be it AAPS for last mile banking, e-KYC for identity verification, Aadhaar enabled DBT for direct fund transfer or authentication, Aadhaar, the foundation of India's digital public infrastructure and a tool for good governance, is playing a greater role in improving the ease of living for residents.

HYDERABAD. Hyderabad has dominated South India's skyline with a notable share in the tall buildings' landscape. That's not all. Hyderabad emerges as the second Indian city in rising vertically, which is aimed at moving closer to the city centres. According to Sky is the Limit: Rise of Tall Buildings in India by CBRE, Hyderabad has accounted for eight percent of overall tall buildings which are at a height of above 150 meters and this is the second highest in the country after Mumbai. Both Bengaluru and Chennai lag far behind Hyderabad with 1 percent share in tall buildings. There are 24 tall buildings in Hyderabad that are either completed or under construction including Lodha Bellezza, SAS Crown, My Home 99, Poulomi Palazzo, My Scape Yoo Hyderabad. Among all, SAS Crown in Kokapet rises to a height of 235 meters which would be the tallest one in Hyderabad. The growth in Greater Hyderabad has led to expansion towards the north and east, which have transformed from residential outskirts into important parts. West Hyderabad is known for its prestige and premium location and has become a hub for high-rise clusters. This densely populated area enjoys good connectivity through public transportation and road networks and commands a premium real estate price compared to other parts of the city. Among other cities, Kolkata, and Noida account for seven percent, and 5 percent of the tall buildings in India, respectively. Gurgaon, Bangalore and Chennai closely follow them, each contributing one percent to the country's tall building landscape. The report also indicates that nearly 89 percent of completed tall buildings in India are dedicated residential buildings, while 6 percent are designated office buildings. Anshuman Magazine, Chairman & CEO - India, South-East Asia, Middle East & Africa, CBRE, said, "Hyderabad, for the past few years, has been cycling vertical growth, presenting another prime example where developers and stakeholders are actively pursuing vertical growth, capitalizing on the favourable Floor Space Index (FSI) regulations in Telangana. BENGALURU: Exactly 14 days from now, India will launch its third unmanned mission to the Moon, Chandrayaan 3. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) officials on Wednesday confirmed that Chandrayaan 3 will be launched at 2.30 pm on July 13. Initially, ISRO Chairman S Somnath had stated that the window that the organisation was looking at for launch was between July 12 and July 19. However, it has been confirmed by officials that the launch will take place on July 13 from Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) in Sriharikota.
