Continued From pg 01 The Election Commission of India (ECI) has released the schedule for the assembly elections in Telangana. Polling for 119 assembly constituencies across the state will be held on November 30 on a single day. As soon as the election schedule is released, the ruling BRS in the state, along with the BJP and the Congress, are planning to enter the public domain. It is known that the BRS party chief and CM KCR has already announced the party's candidates for the assembly constituencies. Both the BJP and the Congress are working on the selection of candidates. The first list of the congress party is likely to be announced in two to three days. In particular, the Congress party high command is very keen on the selection of candidates. Most of the leaders,

who did not get a ticket in the BRS and were dissatisfied with it, joined the Congress party. They will also be considered by the high command in the allotment of the party tickets. With the first list to be released in the next one week, the high command has taken precautionary measures to ensure that the dissidents do not leave the party. Jana Reddy, a former minister and a senior party leader who is known as a troubleshooter, has been fielded by the party high command. He was given key responsibilities by the party high command. The high command is all set to make full use of Jana Reddy's services by fielding him. A four men committee was appointed under the chairmanship of Jana Reddy. Apart from Jana Reddy, the high command has also appointed Manikrao Thakre, Deepadas Munshi and Meenakshi Natarajan in the committee. The committee has been assigned a

key task by the party high command. After releasing the list of the party candidates, it was entrusted with the responsibility of pacifying those who did not get the ticket and disgruntled leaders in the party. The committee members under the leadership of Jana Reddy will meet at Gandhi Bhavan on Wednesday. The committee will focus on the constituencies where there is a competition for the ticket before the allotment of the tickets. The committee headed by Jana Reddy will take steps to ensure that those who did not get the ticket, do not leave the party by pacifying them. There is a lot of competition in many constituencies for the tickets in the Congress party. In some constituencies, new leaders and old leaders are trying hard to get a ticket from the high command.
